It is our great pleasure to inform you that preparations for Europerio 7 are progressing rapidly. The scientific program is almost set and promotion for the Europerio 7 is in full swing. The Ambassadors chaired by Corinna Bruckmann are doing a great job in this regard. In this sense, we would like to share some more information with you.

### Call for Abstracts

On-line abstract submission will begin on Thursday, September 15, 2011 and will be available until Wednesday, November 30, 2011 via [www.europerio7.com](http://www.europerio7.com). We would appreciate it very much, if you could invite your colleagues, students and researchers to submit their papers. On-line registration and accommodation booking for delegates will also start on Thursday, September 15, 2011.

### Translation

The concept for providing translations will be different to previous Europerios: The main auditorium and the dental hygienist session room will be equipped with a translation infrastructure. National societies interested in translation to their language are asked for a cost contribution of app. EUR 7.000,00 net (depending on language and scope of translation). This cost contribution is independent of final number of delegates.

The rationale is: the more delegates from your home country attend, the higher your share in the profit repartition after the congress will be. Promotion of the translational concept will start with the printing of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Announcement early September 2011 and thereafter play an important role in the marketing plan. Thus, to take advantage of all these and your local promotional activities, your principal decision on offering translation is recommended by Monday, July 25, 2011.

English is the official language of the congress. At this stage, the main session and dental hygienist sessions will be translated into German.

## General Information


